## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Entry Fee is \$25 for up to 3 pieces. Entry fee is NON-REFUNDABLE and must be submitted with entry form. All paperwork must be legible.
2. Submission is by digital images only (images may be submitted on a CD or emailed to celisa@cowichecanyon.org). Submit one image of each piece of artwork. Label CD with the artist's name and phone number. Each image file may be no larger than 3 MB and saved as a jpeg file at 72 ppi resolution. Each image file will be labeled with its Number - Last Name - Title. Actual artwork must be identical to the submitted images.
3. No media restrictions; sculpture and jewelry encouraged. Work must be original, inspired by Cowiche Canyon Conservancy lands, and have been completed within the past five years. No more than 3 entries per artist. We reserve the right to refuse artwork that is too fragile, oversized or does not meet conditions of eligibility.
4. A value or price must be stated for all work. Prices should reflect a 70-30 commission. (70% to the artist; 30% to Highland Food Bank.) No more than one "not for sale" (NFS) per artist. The value of the NFS item must be stated for insurance purposes.
5. Accepted / Declined notifications will be mailed as soon after jurying as possible.

**Cowiche Canyon Conservancy** (CCC) is a land trust working to protect shrub-steppe habitat and connect people to the lands. CCC owns and manages



5,000 acres of habitat and offers 30 miles of non-motorized recreational trails through sage and grasslands, flowering meadows, oak woodlands, and basalt cliffs. These lands are home to an array of wildlife, including birds, mammals, reptiles, butterflies and other insects, some of which are dependent on this critical habitat for their survival.
