

COWICHE CANYON WINERY TRAIL

NARRATIVE

A three-quarter mile long side trail connects the Cowiche Canyon Trail with wineries in the Naches Heights area. The Tasting Room of Washington - Wilridge Vineyard and NHV the Naches Heights Vineyard are located near the end of this trail just off Naches Heights Road. The Winery Trail leaves the main trail just west of bridge #8 and climbs the north (left) hillside to the Tasting Room. This canyon rim area contains bike trails, scenic vistas, and picnic areas. The trail can be used by hikers, mountain bikers snowshoers, & horseback riders to access the wineries and viewpoint areas from either the canyon trail or from Naches Heights Road. The wineries and the Canyon trail can also be accessed from Naches Heights Road.

The Cowiche Canyon Conservancy is the owner and sole caretaker of this portion of the trail. Maintenance can be supported by contributions made to Cowiche Canyon Conservancy.

TRAIL LENGTH (AND TERRAIN)

The trail switchbacks for 0.8 miles up the side of the canyon at a fairly steep grade. The footing is a little insecure in places, but the increasingly wider views are spectacular.

DIFFICULTY (ADD COLOR)

Moderate

TRAIL USES (HIKING, BIKING, SKIING, HORSEBACK)

Hiking, biking, snowshoeing, and horseback riding

TRAILHEAD DIRECTIONS (FROM VISITOR CENTER)

See Cowiche Canyon East or Weikel Trailhead directions starting in the Canyon.

Directions to the Naches Heights wineries are:

1. Head **northwest** on **N Fair Ave** toward **B St**
2. Slight right onto **N 10th St**
3. Take the 1st left onto **E Lincoln Ave**
4. Turn right onto **N 40th Ave**
5. Turn left onto **W Powerhouse Rd**
6. Turn left onto **Naches Heights Rd**
