

SMR GARRY OAK TRAIL

TRAIL INFORMATION

NARRATIVE

The Garry Oak Trail starts at a trail sign on the Entry Trail, just across the small irrigation ditch. It wanders through the open area between a grove of oaks and Cowiche Creek, eventually curving around to meet an old service road coming down from Cowiche Mill Road at the west end of the SMR property. The trail leads hikers on a pleasant walk through seasonally colored leaves and bright spots of sunlight.

The Cowiche Canyon Conservancy is the owner and sole caretaker of this portion of the trail. Maintenance can be supported by contributions made to Cowiche Canyon Conservancy.

TRAIL LENGTH (AND TERRAIN)

The trail is .42 miles of gentle sloping riparian terrain.

DIFFICULTY (ADD COLOR)

Easy

TRAIL USES (HIKING, BIKING, SKIING, HORSEBACK)

Hiking, biking, skiing, snowshoeing

TRAILHEAD DIRECTIONS (FROM VISITOR CENTER)

1. Head **southeast** on **N Fair Ave** toward **E Yakima Ave** **0.3 mi**
2. Take the 2nd right toward **E Yakima Ave** **0.1 mi**
3. Turn left onto **E Yakima Ave** **1.5 mi**
4. Turn right onto **Summitview Ave** **10.9 mi**
5. Turn left onto **Cowiche Mill Rd** **2.5 mi**
6. Turn left into the **Snow Mountain Ranch** parking area, across from Cowiche Creek Nursery
