

# WDFW NORTH JEEP ROAD to Box Springs Canyon

### NARRATIVE

This trail crosses shrub-steppe terrain travelling west on an old jeep road to the elk fence, and then to the picturesque head of Box Spring Canyon. It provides expansive views of the open country above the South Fork of Cowiche Creek and Yakima.

Washington State Fish and Wildlife department is the owner of this portion of the trail and maintenance is provided by the Cowiche Canyon Conservancy. Trail maintenance can be supported by contributions made to Cowiche Canyon Conservancy.

### TRAIL LENGTH (AND TERRAIN)

3.29 miles of gently rolling terrain

### DIFFICULTY (ADD COLOR)

Moderate

### TRAIL USES (HIKING, BIKING, SKIING, HORSEBACK)

Hiking, biking, skiing, and horseback

### TRAILHEAD DIRECTIONS (FROM VISITOR CENTER)

1. Head **southeast** on **N Fair Ave** toward **E Yakima Ave** **0.3 mi**
2. Take the 2nd right toward **E Yakima Ave** **0.1 mi**
3. Turn left onto **E Yakima Ave** **1.5 mi**
4. Turn right onto **Summitview Ave** **10.9 mi**
5. Turn left onto **Cowiche Mill Rd** **2.5 mi**
6. Turn left into the **Snow Mountain Ranch** parking area, across from Cowiche Creek Nursery
